HORNSBY SHIRE HOUSING CODE

At this meeting, Councillor Shirley ALEXANDER will speak about the Council Housing Code.

Councillor Alexander prepared Hornsby Councils' submission to the State Government which resulted in Hornsby Shire being exempted from the provisions of State Environment Planning Policy 28 relating to medium density housing.

Exemption gives Council a greater degree of control over medium density housing development within the shire by the application of the guidelines of its own housing code.

Councillor Alexander was responsible for the development and acceptance of this code.

BUSH REGENERATION RECOVERING AUSTRALIAN LANDSCAPES

It is always pleasing to see a friend get good reviews. On March 24th the above-named book was reviewed in the Herald and called "An excellent book". The same day the Australian said "Here is an absolutely splendid book on regenerating our landscapes". It was written by Robin Buchanan who was a member of this Trust's Parks sub-committee until she moved to Mount Ku-ring-gai. Our congratulations to her.

The book (259pp, \$24.95) deals with the problems of recovering both rural and urban landscapes. It has much fascinating information, many tables and diagrams and is profusely illustrated in colour. The sections on botany, soils and plant ecology are of great interest, and easily understood. You will find this book a worthy addition to your library.
