BUSH WALKS ON 30TH MAY AT 2p.m.

For some years now the Trust has arranged an annual walk in Beecroft and Chilworth Reserves for members and friends. This year we are altering the usual format to break the walkers into two groups. Meet at the corner of York Street and Chilworth Place Beecroft just prior to 2p.m. We expect to complete both walks by 4p.m.

The longer walk led by Fred Waddington will show the extent and nature of the surviving bushland from Cheltenham Road to Pennant Hills Golf Club on both sides of Devlins Creek.

The shorter walk will be led by Sheila Woods and will concentrate on two areas where bush regeneration is being carried out by volunteers. You will see how degraded bush can be restored by careful work and with assistance of council. There are now over fifty groups doing this rewarding work within Hornsby Shire. Sheila has completed the Bush Regeneration Certificate course at Ryde College of TAFE (formerly Ryde School of Horticulture).
