COMMISSION OF INQUIRY

The Commission of Inquiry on the F2 Castlereagh Freeway began with its first session on October 24th and its hearing of submissions began on November 9th. The RTA and Government Departments have completed their submissions and on-site inspections have been carried out. The Commission is hearing further submissions at the Ryde Council Chambers at the end of November. Further hearings will be at the Commission offices, ANA House, George St, City in the week 11th to 15th December. This Trust is scheduled to present its submission on the Tuesday, 12th December at approximately 11:00 am. This Trust is registered as group number 20 in a total of 240 groups and individuals making submissions.

All hearings are open to the public. Members of the Trust are encouraged to attend such hearings as are of interest. Evidence of community support will be noted by the commission and will undoubtedly play a part in the determination of such decisions as are reached.
