

Hello all

Just following up Council's commitment by keeping you informed of the pending tree works at 28-32 Malton Road Beecroft.

All hollows have been inspected and I can confirm that there were no animals were present at the time of inspection. Hollows have been blocked off to minimised them being used.

A letterbox drop, to surrounding residents advising of works is being undertaken by Council's Contractor TreeServe today 13/2/2024.

As you are aware, there will be a power outage on Friday 16th February 2024 and the commencement of the removal of tree branches overhanging the High Voltage network to minimise any risk to the tree workers during the removal process.

Two large cranes with traffic control will be utilised to ensure the tree removals can be completed safely. The cranes will be set up on Malton Rd blocking the road and adjacent properties while the work is taking place. Traffic control will be in place and alternate traffic routes could be implemented.

The work is expected to be completed between 07:00am – 17:00pm Friday 16th and Monday 20th. Tuesday 21st is scheduled as a backup day if needed.

Following the completion of the tree removals the stump grinding will be undertaken to reduce the trip hazards.

Once all works have been completed, Council will undertake the installation of nesting boxes in the surrounding area to offset the loss of hollows.

Finally, once the weather cools, Council will undertake the planting of trees.
